# Lake Toba North Sumatera 4 days - 3 nights




View of Lake Toba and Surroundings

## Day 1: Arrival Kualanamu - Lake Toba

Arrive Medan before 11 am. Private transfer to *Lake Toba* (175 km). On the way, visit traditional villages, rubber and palm oil plantations, paddy terraces, etc. Arrive in *Parapat*, cross over to *Samosir* Island by local ferry (45 minutes). Check in hotel. Please note that only simple accommodation is available on Samosir.

## Day 2: Samosir

Breakfast at hotel. Enjoy a half-day tour around the island by motorboat. Visit a traditional Batak Village at *Tobak*. Continue to *Ambarita*. Back to the hotel. Afternoon free program.

**Day 3: Samosir - Parapat - Brastagi - Medan**

Breakfast at hotel. Check out and leave for Brastagi. On the way, stop at a pine tree plantation, visit the Batak King's Palace *Simalungan* at Pematang Purba. Continue to *Sipiso-Piso* Waterfalls. Arrive in Brastagi, which is a refreshing mountain resort surrounded by active volcanoes. Visit the traditional fruit market. Depart for Medan. Arrive and check in hotel.

**Day 4: Medan - Departure**

Breakfast at hotel. Start Medan city tour. Visit the Palace of the Old Deli Sultanate, *the Tjong A Fie Mansion* and other places of interest. Four hours before flight departure proceed to the airport.



# Bohorok Orangutan Center

## North Sumatra

### 3 days - 2 nights



#### Bohorok National Park

##### Day 1: Arrival Kualanamu - Bohorok

Arrive at Medan *Kualanamu* airport before noon, meet and greet then drive to the northwest for about 5 hours to *Bohorok*, also known as Bukit Lawang orangutan center. En route pass through several small towns and enjoy the views of rubber and oil palm plantations. If you are in the right season, stop on the way to see the *rambutan* and cocoa gardens, and enjoy the traditional markets. Arrive in *Bohorok*, check-in at hotel. Please note that only simple accommodation is available at *Bohorok*.

##### Day 2: Bohorok

After breakfast, start a 3 hours jungle trekking to meet the orangutans in the dense tropical rainforest (*no guarantees*). If you are lucky you may not only meet the orangutan, but also the leaf monkey, macaque, gibbons, and abundant bird life. You should be fit to walk and have good quality walking shoes. Return back to the hotel and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Additional trekking programs are available and which must be paid on the spot.

Start touring over the *Sekonyer River* to *Tanjung Puting National Park*. Your onboard cook will prepare dinner for you. Spend the night on a traditional *klotok houseboat*.


### Day 2: Tanjung Puting National Park

Our cook will prepare breakfast for you. Enjoy the tour to the orangutan feeding station at 09.00 am. *Tanjung Puting* national rangers will arrange food for the orangutans at the feeding station. Mother orangutans will bring her baby and children to the platform. Lunch onboard the boat. Continue the journey through the national park. Dinner and overnight on board.

## Day 1: Arrival - Balikpapan - Samarinda - Mahakam

Upon arrival at Balikpapan airport, meeting service and transfer to Loa Janan to board a traditional houseboat for an exciting adventure on the *Mahakam River*. Meals and overnight on houseboat.

## Day 2: Muara Muntai - Mancong - Tanjung Isuy

Short sightseeing at *Muara Muntai Wooden Village*, then cross *Jempang Lake* by motor canoe to *Mancong*. While cruising, enjoy the tropical rain forest and the wild life at *Ohong Creek*.

Upon arrival at *Mancong*, you will be welcomed with a traditional ceremony of the *Dayaq Benuaq*, home to some of the oldest Dayak Longhouses of Kalimantan. Late afternoon visit *Tanjung Isuy* by motor canoe and continue to the houseboat for dinner and overnight. The houseboat will cruise downstream to *Tenggarong*.

## Day 3: Tenggarong - Balikpapan

Arrive at *Tenggarong*, visit the former palace of the Sultan in *Kutai Kertanegara*. Enjoy a look into the collection of the Sultan and the *Dayak* culture. Transfer to Balikpapan airport for your departure flight.







#### Day 01: Arrival Makassar - Toraja

Upon arrival at *Hasanuddin* airport Makassar, meet with our local representative. We will take you out on a picturesque 8 to 9 hours drive to Toraja passing through *Buginese* villages with their traditional houses. Lunch will be served in a seafood restaurant in Pare-Pare. In the afternoon stop at *Puncak Laka-wan* to enjoy a spectacular view. Arrive in *Rantepao* in late afternoon. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

#### Day 02: Tana Toraja

After breakfast at your hotel, you will enjoy a full day exploring *Tana Toraja*.

First you will visit *Lemo* to see rows of *Tau Tau* statues and the hanging graves.

Later we continue to discover the secrets of baby trees in *Kambira*. Onwards to *Londa* with its ancient tombs in which the deceased was not buried, but placed among the rocks. Enjoy lunch in a local restaurant in *Rantepao*. Continue to *Kete Kesu* with a stop in *Karuaya* to enjoy a beautiful panoramic view. From here we will continue with a short walk to *Kete Kesu*, one of the oldest Toraja villages. Here you still find two rows of the original village houses, the traditional ancestral houses of the Toraja people, *Tongkonan*, as well as traditional rice barns with colorful woodcarvings. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

**Day 04: Makassar - City tour - Departure**

After breakfast in your hotel, check out. Enjoy a city tour and visit *Anjungan Losari Beach*, a new icon of Makassar, featuring the 4 different ethnicities in south Sulawesi. Continue to visit *Fort Rotterdam*, which also houses the *Lagaligo Museum* and *Paotere* traditional harbor where you can see the *Phinisi* boats. Enjoy lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch transfer to the airport to catch your flight to your next destination.

Most of the reefs of the *Bunaken National Marine Park* are rich and unspoiled, with pristine and abundant soft coral and fish life in huge concentration.

Diving in and around Bunaken is mostly wall diving and drift diving, but also includes several beautiful coral slopes. There are more than 50 different dive sites, most of them within the park. The variety of both fish and soft coral is outstanding, making this area one of the top places in the world with regards to biodiversity.

*Tasik Divers* highly trained and experienced team is on hand to help you get the best out of your holiday. From snorkelers to novice and experienced divers, we can deliver to all levels. Divers to guide ratio of 4 to 1 means that we dive in small controlled groups, taking into consideration the requirements of depth, certification and photography.

# Visit North Moluccas Ternate - Tidore - Morotai 7 days - 6 nights

## Day 1: Arrival Ternate

Upon arrival at *Babullah* Ternate airport, you will be picked up by our guide and taken to the hotel to check-in. You will begin the visit with a city tour starting with Oranje Fortress, which is the largest Dutch fort on Ternate which was built in 1607 and was once part of the VOC spice trade center.

Continue your visit to the *Kedaton* Sultan of Ternate, *Tapak Dua* Landmark of the City of Ternate, the *Tidore Islands* and *Maitara*. After that, you will be taken back to the hotel.

## Day 2: Explore the Islands

After breakfast, you will be picked up again to start the second day of your tour. First, you will visit the Portuguese-built *Tolukko* Fortress above the foot of *Sangaji Village*, *Batu Angus*, *Sulamadaha Beach*, *Tolire Lake* to witness the

beauty of the lake with blue water and exotic scenery around the summit of *Mount Gamalama*, *Gamalama Fortress*, the oldest fortress in Ternate. After that, you will be taken to the City of Promise Fortress, *Kalamata Fortress*, and finally back to the hotel.

## Day 3: Visit Tidore

After breakfast, you will be picked up by our driver and taken to *Bastiong* Harbor to go to Tidore. It takes around 10-15 minutes by local wooden boat to reach *Tidore*. Upon arrival at Rum Pier in Tidore, you will begin your journey by visiting *Tahulla* fortress, which is another Portuguese fort at the foot of the hill near the village of *Soajawa* overlooking the center of the city of *Soasio* and the sea of *Halmahera*. You will then

proceed to visit the nearby *Tidore Sultanate* Museum, *Fort Tore*, and the *Tidore* Sultan Palace. After that, you will visit the Akesahu hot springs, then return to *Rum Village* where you can see Juan Sebastian Del Cano's Landing Monument, which is the first Spanish racer to set foot on Tidore Island. Finally, return to *Rum Harbor*.



#### **Day 4: Ternate – Morotai**

After breakfast, you will be picked up by the driver around 9.30 am who will take you to Ternate airport for flight check-in. Upon arrival at Leo *Wattimena* Morotai airport, you will be welcomed by our guide. After that, you will be taken to D'Aloha Resort to check in and rest. In the afternoon, you will head to *Tanjung Dehegila* to relax and enjoy the sunset.



#### **Day 5: Morotai Island Tour**

After breakfast, you will be picked up by your driver to start your Morotai Island trip. The first destination is *Tanjung Gorango*. This beach offers a panoramic view of clean white sand beaches, stretching more than half a kilometer, and only about 2.5 hours drive to the northern part of Morotai Island. After lunch, you will return to the south in the village of Bere-Bere, take a local wooden boat called "*ketinting*" and explore the island of *Tabailenge*, which is only about 10 minutes away. In the afternoon, you will be picked up again and taken to *Nunuhu Beach*, which is about one hour from *Bere-Bere*. After that, you are then taken back to the capital city of Daruba. On the way to Daruba, you can stop at *Air Kaca*, which was once a bathing place for the US military commander, General Douglas Mc Arthur during the Asia Pacific War. From here, you are then taken back to the resort to rest.

**Day 6: Island hopping (Pulau Zum-Zum, Pulau Pasir Putih, Pulau Kokoya, Pulau Kolorai, and Pulau Dodola).**

After breakfast, you will be picked up around 9am and taken to Daruba pier to begin your Island-Hopping adventure. The first place to visit is Pulau *Zum-Zum*. The island was once used by General Commander Douglas Mc Arthur as a strategic base to set up a strategy against Japanese forces. You will be taken to Kolorai Island to visit the Village Based Tourism Community, where you can visit the Local Creative Industry Center. The next place to visit is *Pasir Timbul* Island, which is a small uninhabited island floating in the middle of nowhere, but only covered with white sand with very clear water. Next, you will go to *Kokoya* Island. The last destination for your Island-Hopping trip is *Dodola* Island which is a tourism icon

of Morotai Island, which consists of two small islands called *Dodola Besar* and *Dodola Kecil* which are connected by pure white sand at low tide. In the afternoon, you are picked up by a local wooden boat to return to Morotai Island. After that, you are taken back to the hotel.

**Day 7: Morotai - Departure**

After breakfast, start the morning tour. The first place to visit is the Mini World War II Museum which is owned by locals who keep a collection of relics of World War II in their own homes. Then you will stop by the Morotai World War II Museum in Pandanga Village which was built in 2012 to welcome the Sail Morotai event. After that, you will be escorted to the airport and thus, the end of all your adventures in Morotai.

Accordingly, we use reef friendly laundry detergent and bathroom amenities, biodegradable garbage bags, avoid the usage of single-use plastic, and make a point of employing and training locals on as many jobs as possible. We collaborate closely with the foundation *Raja Ampat SEA Centre*, which was initiated by our Papua Explorers Resort.





# Papua Explorers Resort

Papua Explorers Resort is located in the islands of *Raja Ampat*, which is on the northwest tip of the Bird's Head Peninsula of West Papua. Raja Ampat translates into English as Four Kings and gets its name from a local mythology about four kings that occupy the four big islands; *Salawati*, *Batanta*, *Waigeo* and *Misool*. It's a stunning archipelago comprising over 1,500 small islands, hosting thousands of species some of which are endemic to the region.

It is a new regency which separated from *Sorong Regency* in 2004. It encompasses more than 40,000 km<sup>2</sup> of land and sea, which also contains *Cenderawasih Bay*, the largest marine national park in Indonesia. It is a part of the newly named West Papua (province) of Indonesia which was formerly *Irian Jaya*.

The main occupation for people around this area is fishing since the area is dominated by the sea. They live in a 2 small colony of tribes that spreads around the area. Although traditional culture still strongly exists, they are very welcoming to visitors. Their religion is predominantly Christian.

On arrival at Tambolaka airport, our guide will meet you and transfer to *Manandang* hotel or similar for overnight. Afternoon city tour and visit the traditional market and villages nearby the city of *Waikabubak* such as: *Prai Ijing*, *Tarung* and *Wai Tabar* to see the stone graves and traditional houses of the *Sumbanese* people. Also visit the local market of *Waikabubak*. Afternoon return to hotel for dinner and overnight.

##### **Day 2: Waikabubak - Anakalang - Mamboro Country Side**

After breakfast, your guide will pick you up then start the tour to *Anakalang* Area to visit: *Pasunga*, (Megalithic Tombs constructed in 1926) *Lai Tarung*, to see the house of Marapu/ancestors, *Galu Bakul* Village to see The Royal tombs King of *Anakalang* (Umbu Sawola) then drive to *Mamboro* country side and stop at some villages: *Manuakalada*, *Wawarongu* and *Tamber*. Picnic lunch will provided on the way. During this trip you can enjoy the view of the rice fields, green hills and savannah with the Flores Ocean on the background. In afternoon return to your hotel.

After breakfast at hotel transfer to *Tambolaka* airport to catch your flight to your next destination.

Then drive to Artisan's village of *Celuk*, known for its silver jewelry workshops, and Mas recognized for its wood carving galleries. Meet the artisans at work to understand the creative process.

Journey continues to *Kintamani* for a unique lunch (at own account) experience facing the majestic cone of *Batur Volcano* and its vast crater lake. (Optional) Lunch is followed by a drive, which descends *Penelokan Hill* to the *Tirta Empul* Temple, known as the "Holy Water Temple". Next visit to *Gunung Kawi* Royal Monument with its impressive valley view. From the main entrance, descend about 300 steps to reach the Royal tombs and hermitage caves. Drive towards *Tegalalang* to see one of Bali's best rice terraces. Stops can be made along the way at *Ubud's* many galleries if you wish to buy some of Bali's art pieces to take home.


