BUDDHIST & Mughal Heritage Trip

Day 1 Arrival Lahore

Lahore is Pakistan's second largest city and the capital of the north-eastern Punjab province. It is widely considered the country's cultural capital.

Day 2 Lahore-Wagha Border - Lahore

Visit Lahore Fort, Badshahi Mosque, Lahore Central Museum, Shalimar Gardens. After that leave for Whagha Border to witness the famous flag ceremony parade of Pakistani and Indian border security forces.

Day 3 Lahore - Khewra Salt Mine - Islamabad

Visit Khewra Salt Mine which is not only Pakistan's largest and oldest salt mine it is also the world's second largest. It is a major tourist attraction.

Day 4 Islamabad - Taxila - Peshawar

Taxila was once the seat of oriental culture. It is famous for the rare specimens of stucco from the Gandhara period excavated from Sirkap and various Buddhist stupas and monasteries. The museum houses various objects and sculptures dating from the 4th century BC and the 5th century AD.

Day 5 Peshawar - Takht-eBahi - Swat

Sightseeing Peshawar and visit Peshawar Museum. Continue to Takht-eBahi Buddhist Monastery dating back to 1st century AD. Overnight in Mangora, Swat Valley.

Day 6 Swat - Islamabad

Visit Swat Museum which has a rich collection of Gandhara art. Budkara is another historical Buddhist archaeological site at Mingora town, the commercial center of Swat. Continue to Islamabad.

Day 7 Islamabad - Departure

City tour of Islamabad. Visit Lok Virsa Museum, Pakistan Monument and Shahr-e Pagan and Faisal Mosque.
