The Ancient Silk Road Trail & Kalash Mountain Tribe

Day 1 Arrival Islamabad

Arrive Islamabad and overnight

Day 2 Islamabad – Naran

Departure by car for Naran located in Gilgit Baltistan which is one of the world's most untouched places to visit.

Day 3 Naran – Gilgit – Hunza

Departure for Gilgit. Stop at Laluser Lake and Babuser Pass (4160m). Lunch break at Chilas. Drive on the famous Karakoram Highway to Gilgit City. Continue to Hunza Valley (2500m) a beautiful Valley known for its splendid beauty. On the way stop at Rakaposhi viewpoint.

Day 4 Hunza – Gulmit

Visit 900 years old Baltit Fort, Altit Village, Altit Fort. Enjoy a boat-ride on Attabad Lake. In Gulmit visit a local museum, women carpet weaving center, the longest suspension foot bridge. Overnight Gulmit.

Day 5 Gulmit – Khunjerab Pass – Gulmit

Visit the legendary Khunjerab Pass (the world's highest border crossing) that connects China with Pakistan. En-route enjoy a spectacular view of Shisper Peak (7611m), Batura Peak and others. Picnic lunch at Khunjerab Pass and drive back to Gulmit.

Day 6 Gulmit – Hoper Valley – Minapin

Visit the beautiful Hoper Valley where we will hike up to a viewpoint for a beautiful view of the Hoper Glacier and the surrounding mountain peaks. Continue to Minapin.

Day 7 Minapin – Gilgit – Phander

Leave for Phander. Follow the Ghizer River and reach Ghahkoch. Lunch with trout fish at Khalti Lake. The Khalti Valley is surrounded by lofty snow-capped mountains. Continue to Phander.

Day 8 Phander – Bumi (Chitral Valley)

Today enjoy a long drive to Chitral. En-route stop at Lunger and Shandoor Polo ground which is the world's highest polo ground. Continue to Bumi for overnight.

Day 9 Kalash Valley

Drive to Chitral and apply for a special permit to visit the Kalash Valley, which is home to the indigenous Kalash tribe. Kalash Valley has been incorporated by UNESCO as a cultural heritage site. Overnight at Bamburate.

Day 10 Kalash Valley

Explore the beauty of Kalash Valley and meet the local people. Enjoy the landscape. Visit Kalash museum, local villages and enjoy traditional dances. Meet the local women in traditional costumes. Visit a traditional cemetery. Overnight at Bamburate.

Day 11 Kalash Valley – Islamabad

Drive back to Islamabad by car which takes about 14 hours via Lowari Tunnar and Malakand Pass. Dinner and overnight Islamabad.
