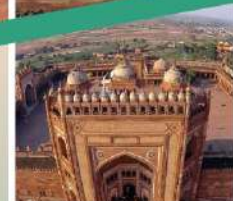

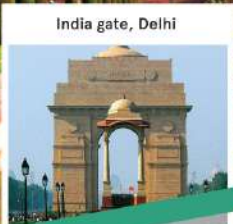

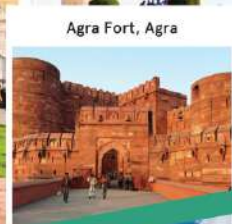

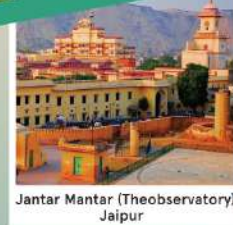

## Day 1: Arrive Delhi

Arrive at Delhi Indira Gandhi International Airport, meet and greet by our local representative. Transfer to hotel. Check in time from 12.00 noon onwards

## Day 2: Delhi sightseeing

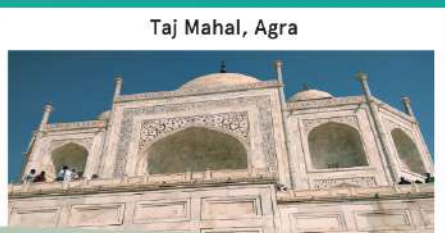
Full day sightseeing to the Old and New Delhi. Visit e.g., Jama Masjid (India's largest mosque), Raj Ghat, the memorial site where Mahatma Gandhi was cremated in the Old Delhi. Continue to New Delhi and visit Bangla Sahib which is a sacrosanct worship place for Sikhs and a drive along the ceremonial avenue – Rajpath, past the imposing India Gate, Parliament House, and the President's Residence.

## Day 3: Delhi – Agra (Taj Mahal)

Drive to Agra to visit the legendary Taj Mahal which is a must to see for anyone in this world. Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays. Visit Agra Fort; the rusty and majestic red-sandstone fort of Agra constructed by Emperor Akbar in 1566.

## Day 4: Agra – Fatehpur Sikri – Jaipur (Rajasthan)

Drive to the Jaipur via Fatehpur Sikri and visit the famous mosque with the holy Dargah of Khawaja. Also visit Khwaja Salem Chishti one of Mughals' finest architectural examples. Continue to heritage city of Jaipur also known as the Pink city.

## Day 5: Jaipur

Visit Amber Fort located outside the main city. Enjoy a tour to the City Palace, Hawa Mahal, (Palace of Winds), Jantar Mantar (the Royal Observatory) and finally the Albert Museum which has a vast collection of art objects belonging to the various Maharajas of Japiur. There will be plenty of time left for shopping. Overnight at hotel.

## Day 6: Jaipur – Delhi – Departure

Morning free program until departure for Delhi International Airport by road. Checkout time from hotel 12.00 noon. Journey will take about 6 hours. 12.00. Check in for your departure flight. Instead of catching the flight to Jakarta, however, you could also extend your stay in India and catch a flight to another exotic destination e.g., Goa, Varanasi or Kerala.
